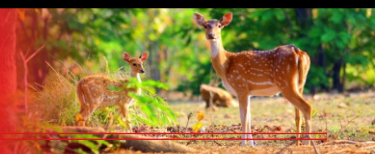

Abstract Submission Guidelines (Oral / Poster)

Poster Size–	80 cm. (Width) x 110 cm. (Height)
Language–	Abstract must be typed and presented in English
Word Limit–	The abstract must be written within 300 words, excluding title and the name of the author(s) and their institutions.
Font–	The abstract must be written in Times New Roman with font size 12.
Contents for case series –	The submitted abstracts must contain the following – Objective : State the main objective of the study. Material & Methods : Briefly describe the design of the study and how it was conducted Result : Present the main results with appropriate statistics. Conclusion : Limit the conclusions to those that are directly supported by the result.
Contents for case report –	Introduction, Case Summary, Conclusion
Title–	The title of the abstract must be typed in CAPITAL LETTERS with the exception of scientific names, which should be in upper and lower case forms and italicized.
Presenting Author Details–	The presenting author's name must be underlined. The presenting author's name, institution, address, telephone and e-mail address must be provided. Presenting author must be registered for the conference. Only registered delegates will be allowed to present.
Deadline –	Deadline of abstract submission is 31 st August 2026. No abstract will be entertained after 31 st August 2026 for selection, submission or presentation.
Acceptance–	Presenting author shall be notified about the status of the abstract after being reviewed by the committee, by e-mail. Authors selected for Poster or Oral presentation will be informed. Communication will only be made by e-mail in this regard. Hence including e-mail address along with abstract is mandatory.
Registration –	Registration for conference is not mandatory for abstract submission, however if abstract or paper gets selected, then registration for the conference becomes mandatory for presentation of the same.
Your abstract will be scored on the following criteria –	* Scientific merit of the abstract. * Adequate sample size and proper statistical analysis. * Adherence to instructions * Originality of work (no meta analysis)

Best 10 posters will be selected for oral presentation (6+2 min.). Award will be given to both poster/oral presentation.

NAINITAL: Situated amidst Kumaon Hills and blessed with beautiful lakes Nainital has earned the epithet of “Lake district of India”. It is known as a paradise for tourists because of its beautiful landscape and serene surroundings. The other tourist attractions are Raj Bhavan, Zoo, Naina Devi Temple, Bhimtal, Sattal, Naukuchiatal and Khurpatal.

CORBETT NATIONAL PARK: Jim Corbett National Park, can be befittingly called the paradise of Tigers for the fact, that it holds a large population of tigers in its breathtaking landscapes that consists of different varieties of flora and fauna. Named after the legendary Tiger hunter turned Naturalist Jim Corbett, the proud destination 'Jim Corbett National Park' was the first national park of India, established in 1936 in the hill state of Uttarakhand in Northern India. It is one of the most famous wildlife destinations, visited by several wildlife enthusiasts who want to catch the glorious sights of the Indian tigers.

Spread across the districts Nainital and Pauri, the Corbett National Park covers an area of 1288 sq. km, together with neighboring reserves- Sonanadi Wildlife Sanctuary and Reserve Forest. It is home to approximately 110 tree species, 50 mammal species, 580 bird species, and 25 reptile species that are found both in the lower and higher regions of the park. The geographical location of this place that encloses streams, rivers, and ridges crisscrossing the terrain, makes Jim Corbett National Park a perfect habitat for numerous plant and animal species. There are 2 safaris (Jeep Safari & Elephant Safari) options at the Jim Corbett National Park.

RANIKHET: Ranikhet, widely known as “Queen's Meadow” is a scenic hill station of Almora district. According to folklore, Queen Padmini of Kumaon region once visited the town. Awestruck by the beauty of the place, she decided to stay there and the place got its name. The place offers opportunity to relax amidst lush Green Pine, Oak and Deodar trees. The places to visit are Jhula Devi Temple, Binsar Mahadev, Kumaon Regimental Museum and Memorial Centre.

ALMORA: Almora is a picturesque district in the Kumaon region, in the state of Uttarakhand. Almora with a breathtaking panoramic view of Himalayas is a town bustling with activity and a rich cultural heritage history, unique handicrafts, sumptuous cuisine and magnificent wildlife.
